


Vehicles and Driving Policy

Mobcrete is committed to the health and wellbeing of its personnel and to providing vehicles and vehicle/driving management systems to enable safe operation and interaction.

Legislation places a duty of care on the employer to provide a safe working environment; this is extended to driving during the course of normal duties.

Mobcrete shall use the following strategies to implement this policy:

- Ensure all vehicles, used for work purposes are subject to a risk assessment involving the operators who shall use the equipment.
- Establish a partnership where Mobcrete and its personnel adopt a safe approach to the task of driving.
- Ensure all personnel are deemed competent and licensed to operate a vehicle. Competence includes the ability to assess hazards for the vehicle and tasks for which it is to be used.
- Ensure regular maintenance and inspection processes are in place to ensure vehicles are fit for purpose. These include scheduled maintenance by a licensed automotive specialist and daily vehicle pre-start checks.
- Ensure all personnel complete a site specific driving induction and hold a valid driver's license for the designated state or territory.
- Ensure the driver and all passengers understand and adhere to legislation and site specific rules when operating vehicles.
